

CLASS SIZE REDUCTION REPORT TO PARENTS/PUBLIC

Central Stickney School District #110 since FY 2000 has used No Child Left Behind (NCLB-Title II) funds to reduce class size in our Kindergarten classes. The district has again applied for these funds for this purpose.

The district was able to reduce class size through the use of Title II funds by utilizing 2 sections of Kindergarten rather than one. This has enabled us to keep our Kindergarten classrooms in the area of about 20 students per classroom. These class size reductions have resulted in a better instructional environment where teachers may focus more specifically on individual, instructional skill development.
